

How Your Fundraising Helps



£10 could plant 100 mangrove trees. Did you know that Mangrove forests absorb 10 times more carbon than terrestrial ecosystems? This puts them at the frontline of positive climate change.



£50 could allow us to feed 200 people a hot meal.

As many as 811 million people worldwide go to bed hungry each night.



£500 could provide 5 people in India with a vital cataract operation to renew their sight.

In India cataracts have been reported to be responsible for 50-80% of those bilaterally blind in the country.




£1,000 could give children in India access to 500 library books and a learning space.

If your sponsors are UK tax payers, make sure they tick the Gift Aid box when they donate. For every £1 donated, Go Dharmic gets an extra 25p at no extra cost to the donor!

Go Further With Your Fundraising

We're full of ideas to give your fundraising a boost.

Try these simple suggestions and you'll reach your goal in no time!

To raise



Share your online fundraising page on payday – typically, the last Friday of every month. Who doesn't feel more generous when they've just been paid?





Easily launch a birthday fundraiser on social media to reach your friends & family.



Offer to walk your friends' or neighbours' dogs on your rest days in return for a donation.



Organise a treasure hunt in your home, or around your local town, for family and friends, and ask for donations to enter. Everyone loves an activity!



Have a clear-out and head for a car boot sale. You'll be amazed at how much you can raise from things you no longer need.

Hold your own quiz night. You can ask your local pub or workplace to host the event and charge for entry.



Organise a bake sale at work or school – and give a prize to whoever makes the best cake? Nothing like a little healthy(ish) competition, and everyone loves a cake.



Organise a raffle. Contact local shops and businesses to ask for donations you can use as prizes. If you'd like a letter from us confirming what you're doing, iust let us know.

The big fundraiser!



Host your own event! Pick something that you are passionate about and invite others to create new memories, whilst raising money from ticket sales. Host a yoga class, celebrate a cultural festival or organise a music concert.

Keep It Legal

Fundraising is all about having fun, but there are some important legal points to bear in mind.

Organising a raffle or lottery:

- You cannot sell tickets to anyone under 16.
- To run a public raffle or lottery, you will need to apply to your local authority or council for a licence.
- For private raffles or a lottery, you do not need a licence as long as the tickets are only sold to staff at a workplace or members of a club.

Health and Safety:

- Keep in mind personal safety whilst planning your event and on the day of the event
 Go Dharmic cannot take any responsibility for your activity, so it is very important that you complete your own risk assessment.
- Everyone involved in preparing and serving food needs a basic understanding of food hygiene.
- You may need to be registered with your local authority For more information visit food.gov.uk/safety-hygiene/providing-food-at-community-and-charity-events

Insurance:

- Venues usually have their own insurance, but check whether the public are covered.
- You are not able to use Go Dharmic's public liability insurance to cover your own fundraising events.
- Go Dharmic cannot accept any liability for any event you organise, so it is important to ensure that you have arranged appropriate insurance cover ahead of your event.

Collecting Money:

• If you plan to hold a collection on private property, such as a pub or shopping centre, you need to gain permission from the owner or manager. If you collect on the street you must obtain a permit from the local authority for the area you wish to collect in.

Other points to remember:

• Let us know about the event you are planning and we can ensure that you are properly supported. If you would like to use the Go Dharmic logo on anything, such as leaflets, banners etc., please contact us for advice as use of our logo requires our express permission.

Enthuse/Just Giving


