

Terms & Conditions – Himalayan Retreat with Hanuman Dass

1. General Information

- This retreat is organized by Go Dharmic and led by Hanuman Dass & Friends.
- The retreat will be held from October 18th October 27th, 2025, across the Himalayan foothills of Uttarakhand, India, concluding in Rishikesh.
- Participation is limited to a maximum of 40 guests.
- The focus of the retreat is on spiritual practice (Sadhana), selfless service (Seva), and pilgrimage to sacred sites.

2. Eligibility & Participation

- Open to individuals 18 years or older.
- Participants should be in good physical and mental health, and able to handle moderate physical activity and high-altitude conditions.
- A basic level of fitness is recommended, as the itinerary involves walking, light hiking, and temple visits.
- Participants must have a sincere interest in spirituality, yoga, meditation, and Indian culture.
- It is the participant's responsibility to ensure they fully understand the nature and structure of the retreat before registering.

3. Registration & Payment

Registration cost £2000 per person is required and to be paid, which goes directly to supporting Go Dharmic's global humanitarian projects.





- This donation includes:
 - Accommodation for the entire retreat duration.
 - All vegan meals (prepared in accordance with Ayurvedic & Sattvic principles).
 - All scheduled group activities, satsangs, workshops, and guided temple visits.
 - Local group transport within Uttarakhand, including transfers from Pantnagar Airport on arrival and to Dehradun Airport on departure.
- Not included: International flights, domestic flights, visa fees, personal expenses, and travel insurance.
- Full payment is required to confirm booking unless otherwise agreed upon in writing with the organizers.
- Payments are non-refundable, except under limited conditions stated below.
- Please note: Any special arrangements, including deposit payments, partial contributions, or installment-based payments, are non-refundable under all circumstances. As this is a charitable retreat, all funds go directly toward confirmed logistics, accommodations, and program costs, and cannot be reallocated once committed.

4. Cancellation Policy

- Cancellations made before August 10th, 2025: Eligible for a 50% refund of the donation made.
- Cancellations made on or after August 10th, 2025: No refund will be provided.
- If the retreat is cancelled by the organizers due to unforeseen circumstances, a full refund will be issued.
- Travel insurance covering cancellations and medical emergencies is mandatory.

5. Accommodation & Meals

- Participants will stay at the Go Dharmic Peace Centre or partner resorts in Uttarakhand and Rishikesh.
- Accommodations are simple, clean, and shared (based on same-gender unless otherwise arranged).
- Meals provided will be 100% vegan, Sattvic, and designed to support the spiritual process.
- No alcohol, smoking, or non-vegetarian food is permitted during the retreat.

6. Travel & Transportation

- Participants must:
 - Arrive at Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi.
 - Book a domestic flight to Pantnagar Airport on October 18th (2 daily flights available).
 - Book their return flight from Dehradun Airport on October 27th, as the retreat concludes in Rishikesh.
- Group transport from Pantnagar to Guniyalekh and from Rishikesh to Dehradun Airport is included.
- Participants are responsible for international and domestic flight bookings, visa arrangements, and any personal travel outside the retreat itinerary.





7. Health & Safety

- Participants must disclose medical conditions, allergies, or dietary restrictions in advance.
- Basic first-aid will be available; participants must carry their own prescription medication.
- The retreat takes place in remote, medical care.

- Medical and travel insurance is compulsory for all attendees.
- Participants must comply with all safety guidelines and instructions from the retreat team.

8. Code of Conduct

- All participants are expected to:
 - Show respect, mindfulness, and consideration toward fellow participants, local culture, and the natural environment.
 - Follow the daily retreat schedule including yoga, meditation, seva, and satsang.
 - Refrain from alcohol, tobacco, and recreational drug use.
 - Dress modestly and behave respectfully at all sacred sites.
- Disruptive behavior or violation of these rules may lead to dismissal from the retreat without refund.

9. Weather & Packing Recommendations

October temperatures range from 10°C to 25°C - cool mornings and warm afternoons.





Recommended items:

- Warm layers (sweaters, jackets, shawls)
- Modest, comfortable clothing for yoga and temple visits
- Walking shoes
- Yoga mat
- Refillable water bottle
- Toiletries and medications
- Notebook and pen for journaling
